Objective: To practice the sounds /d/ and /I/ while telling someone what they like and dislike
Level: Intermediate
Time: 50 min
Material: Power point with pictures of Mrs. Dafoe's likes and dislikes. plus cheat sheet attached at bottom

Introduction: Begin the class by going through the PowerPoint for about slides each one will have a picture of Mrs. Dafoe doing something or showing something, she likes and dislikes. The teacher will then ask the students why they think the teacher is sharing these photographs. She then will ask them whether they think she likes it or does not like it. (If Mrs. Dafoe is absent there is a cheat sheet on which pictures are likes and which are dislikes at the bottom of the Lesson Plan). The class will then brainstorm other words they can use for liking and do not like that start with d and I. (Ex// love, dislike, disgusted) they will then brainstorm things that they like and dislike that start with I and d and the teacher will write them on the board to use for the next portion of the lesson. Before moving on to the activity the teacher will teach where are the sounds / $\mathrm{d} /$ and /I/ made in the mouth? What is the difference between the two sounds?

Main Activity: Students are separated into groups of 4. In those groups, each student will take turns performing charades of what they do like or do not like. The catch is that they must use the items they have brainstormed on the board. The rest of their group will guess what the student is doing or trying to convey. They then guess whether the student likes or dislikes it. The student keeps going until someone's guess is wrong and then switches with another student in their group. Each student takes a turn in their group and whoever gets the most guessed correctly wins. The winners in each group will then take turns doing the same thing but this time it will be in front of the entire class. Whoever gets the most guessed correctly will be the ultimate winner.

Closing: Each student must share what they like about English and what they dislike about English.
